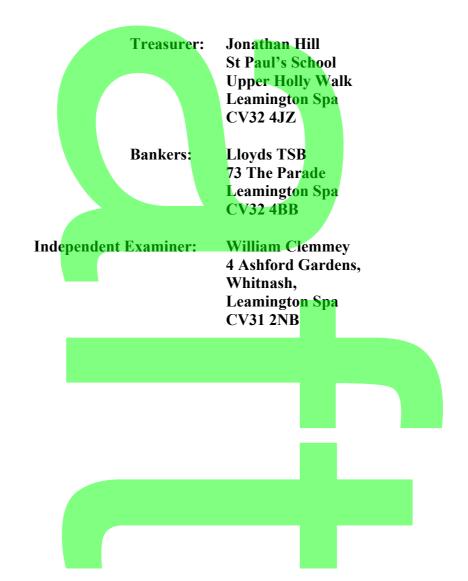

Aims, Organisation and activities

The objective of the charity is to advance the education of the pupils of St Paul's School. The policy of the charity is to:

- Develop extensive relationships between the staff, parents and others associated with the school.
- Engage in activities which support the school and advance the education of pupils attending it.
- Provide and assist in the provision of such facilities and items for education at the school, as the committee in consultation with the Governing Body shall from time to time determine.

The charity is organised as an independent association of all parents and or guardians of pupils attending St Paul's school and all teachers. It may also include past parents, grandparents, friends of the school, ancillary staff and governors. Its Managing Committee comprises elected members.

Activities include fund raising events, donation of funds and equipment to the school and provision of school uniform.

Progress and achievements

Our general income has again increased this year. Overall we made approximately £850 surplus which we will be able to use to support the children in our school.

Operating expenses

We continue to provide school uniforms for purchase and this is a valued service with over £2000 of orders this year. We made a small surplus of £220 on sales this year. New processes have been put in place for better stock control and this will hopefully help reduce the amount of stock going missing. We have also negotiated a deal with Tesco to provide uniform online which will give us an income on everything they sell.

While there were no major donations from large organisations in this year's accounts, Aubrey Allen Butchers generously provided refreshments at the Christmas and Summer Fairs raising approximately £440 in the process. At the time these accounts were prepared, several agreed donations from local organisations relating to the Summer Fair were still outstanding, and these will be carried forward to the 2013/14 accounts.

We have managed to maintain the level of our donations to improving the lives of the pupils at the school this year with donations of £10,006 (2012: £10,300). £2000 had been agreed towards the Early Years outdoors area, but only £1611 has so far been donated. £1058 was donated to the School to purchase science topic equipment. £412 was donated to enable the purchase of more digital cameras. The remainder of the £5,000 allocated last year for the development of the Outdoor area was also donated.

The remainder of the Year's expenditure covered operating expenses, including the cost of fundraising.

Finances

The attached financial statements show the current state of the finances which are considered to be sound.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of St Paul's Parent Teacher Association

I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 31 August 2013, which are set out on pages 5 to 8.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

Basis of independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair view' and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.
